Provide Bagged Lunches to our shelters

Group members prepare bagged lunches off site and deliver to the shelter – by appointment, a tour of the shelter can be provided at the time of delivery of the lunches. **Lunches are particularly needed during the last two weeks of the month.** Delivery should be made prior to 11:00 am. A minimum of 50 lunches are requested for MainSpring House and 40 lunches for Father Bill's Place. Lunches should include: *Sandwich (peanut butter & jelly, turkey, ham, tuna, or cheese); chips or pretzels – individual size bags; fruit – apple, banana, or orange; cookies or candy – individual size (optional); juice or water (optional).*
