Gift Cards provide families the opportunity to shop for gifts for their children and purchase basic needs, such as food. Gift cards can be provided in any denomination to large stores such as Walmart, Target, Stop & Shop, Shaw's, or Market Basket. Popular among teens in our shelters are gift cards to Amazon, iTunes, and GameSpot, and to fast-food restaurants, such as Dunkin Donuts.



Winter Gear such as new hats, gloves, jeans, hooded sweatshirts, sweatpants, thermal shirts and pants, hand and feet warmers, boots (sizes 8-12), and outdoor blankets help protect guests from the winter elements. New or used, cleaned winter coats are also needed. For kids, pajamas, gloves, hats, scarves, and socks.



Cash donations provide the greatest flexibility to respond to needs in the community as they arise. We direct 89 cents of every dollar donated to those we serve.



Prepared meals are needed for guests of our emergency shelters. We are not in need of canned goods or pantry items. Visit helpfbms.org/meals for more info.



Ongoing needs include baby diapers, formula, and wipes, twin and full sheet sets, towels, adult-sized backpacks and drawstring bags, men's & women's undershirts and underwear, ponchos, blankets, deodorant, individual size soap, and individual size shaving cream.
